Sermon Notes:

BACKGROUND OF PASSAGE

- God appears to Abraham for the purpose of testing him
- Mountain of Moriah: 50 miles / 3 days
- God gives Abraham strongest promise possible

WHY DOES GOD TEST US?

- Hebrew = examine, investigate, prove, scrutinize
- Greek = prove, examine, and, by implication, to approve.
- The objective of testing is to discover the truth...NOT to trick or harm us
- God tests us for our own good
- God tests us so we can grow spiritually
- God tests us to reward us
- God tests us to reveal what is in our hearts
- God tests us to purify us and refine us
- God tests us to keep us from sinning
- God tests our obedience to him
- God tests our love for him
- God sometimes tests us to keep us humble. God tests and proves our character.
- God tests us to bring glory to God

WHAT IS NOT A TEST?

- God does not send sickness, disease, or calamity into our lives
- We do not decide when someone else is being tested...

HOW DO WE KNOW IF WE ARE BEING TESTED?

- God may be testing you if a trial in life is causing you to rejoice because of the faith God has granted you
- God is testing you if a trial is making you aware of your need for more faith in Him
- God is testing you if a difficult trial is giving you an opportunity to reap the rewards of trusting Him

Question To Discuss:

Have you ever felt like God was testing you? If so, why do you think He was and what was the result? Did your faith deepen? Do you feel more dependent on Him?
