INTRODUCTION

- Pentecost

- Ex: fearfully and wonderfully made

HOLY SPIRIT

- The Church is supposed to operate under the power of the Holy Spirit
- Often we don't

HOW GOD DESIGNED IT

- John 14:15-17 – If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate (comforter), to be with you forever. This is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, because he abides with you, and he will be in you.
- Isaiah 20:21-22 – And when you turn to the right or when you turn to the left, your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, "This is the way; walk in it." Then you will defile your silver-covered idols and your gold-plated images. You will scatter them like filthy rags; you will say to them, "Away with you!"
- John 14:26 – But the Advocate (comforter), the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything, and remind you of all that I have said to you.

WHAT WE DO INSTEAD

- Addiction = anything we cannot lay down of our own will, anything we can't stop doing on our own
- We find "comfort" in those things even as they destroy us.

HOW DO WE COME TO GOD FOR COMFORT?

- Believing and meditating on the truth
- Repenting and accountability
- Isn't there more than this?
