## Sermon Notes:

### INTRODUCTION

- Last week: Job and his family and Galatians 6
- This week: Satan talks to God – Job loves you because you bless him
- Next week Job refuses to curse God

### BACKGROUND OF PASSAGE

- Who are the “heavenly beings”?
- “Satan” means “adversary”
- God knew what Satan was doing
- Ever since Satan tempted Eve to eat the forbidden fruit, his goal has been to bring temptation and sin to us
- Satan wants to place temptation before Job to get him to curse God
- God allows Satan to tempt us—we are not puppets on a string. But we can resist temptation. We will not do this perfectly, but we can learn what tempts us and what doesn’t, and begin to stay away from things that do. *Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. James 4:7*

- Hard passage – why would a loving God do this?

### FOR US TODAY

- No matter what happened, Job refused to blame God for what happened
- This is where we often get stuck: we expect certain things because of our belief and we expect blessings despite our sinfulness
- We have to start from the premise that God doesn’t actually owe us anything
- He promises us many things, but He doesn’t owe us. When we see it that way – that God owes us nothing – it is easier for us to be grateful for what we have

### This week:

- Take an inventory – are there places I am bitter against God because He didn’t give me something I feel I deserved?
- Have I fallen into the trap of thinking God is a vending machine – if I put in the right combination of prayers and service, I should get what I want?
- Can I take time to repent of this, and show gratitude to God for what He has given me?
