## Sermon Notes:

### INTRODUCTION

- Last week: Satan talks to God – Job loves you because you bless him
- Today: Job refuses to curse God
  - How did Job respond?
  - How do we respond to attacks by the enemy and how do we respond to the fact we live in a fallen world?

### BACKGROUND OF PASSAGE

- The first set of losses... (1:13-22)
- Satan attacks Job's character a second time... (2:1-6)
- The second series of Job's losses... (2:7-10)
- Job's wife loses faith

### FOR US TODAY

- Bad things happen for three reasons:
  - We are reaping the consequences of our own sin
  - Satan is attacking us – spiritual warfare
  - We live in a fallen world – it is not perfect, and bad things happen
- *“Discipline yourselves, keep alert. Like a roaring lion your adversary the devil prowls around, looking for someone to devour.”* 1 Peter 5:8
- *“The enemy comes to steal, kill, and destroy...but I have come that you may have abundant life.”* John 10:10
- How do we know why bad things happen to us?
- How do we respond when bad things happen?
- Example of where the enemy is subtly attacking everyone – distraction
- SLIDE – Quote by Ravi Zacharias
- How strong is our faith? How important is our faith?
- The enemy is attacking all of us in this area – what is important to us? How do we live that out? Do we keep reaching over and over for the cotton candy? The things that entertain and excite? Or are we committing ourselves to the meat and vegetables that we know will sustain?
- Take a look at your life this week: Are you satisfied with your relationship with God? Are you growing? Or are you distracted?
